




Age group of respondents

How often would you normally travel pre Covid-19?






When do you think you'll feel comfortable travelling again?






Once travel restrictions are lifted, will you travel more or less than you would have pre COVID-19?

Who will you be travelling with?




What changes do you think hostels will need to make before reopening safely?


- Hand sanitiser in dorms/ throughout hostels
- Staff / guests should wear masks
- Reduced occupancy in rooms / 50%
- Use top and bottom bunks only
- Better cleaning Sanitise room after someone has left.

- Temperature checks and travel health questionnaires, potential isolation rooms
- Contactless check ins / keys
- Make check ins faster and with less communication and contact.
- Refrain from buffets / Takeaway breakfast boxes
- Visible health and safety procedures for staff and guests.


On your next trip would you prefer to stay in a dorm or private room?




If a hotel was cheaper than a hostel, would you want to book this instead?




What are your main concerns about travelling again?




What will be the most important factors when you book accommodation? Tick all that apply




How important is it in the following months after the travel bans are lifted that hostel/hotel staff wear masks and have access to hand sanitising products?




How important is it to see social distancing measures in place at venues, such as reception line distancing and spacing between seating in restaurant areas?




If hostels/hotels have set up new health & safety procedures, how would you want to find out?




Will you be hesitant to join in on hostel/hotel activities, such as pub crawls, tours & social activities after the travel ban has been lifted?




Will you be willing to visit countries that have been particularly affected by the pandemic?
